Málaga, March 7, 2024. Iberseries & Platino Industria has unveiled the initial details of its upcoming fourth edition at MAFIZ, the Málaga Festival Industry Zone. The event will be held from October 1 to 4 in Matadero Madrid, with the support of EGEDA and Fundación Secuoya, in collaboration with FIPCA. It will also have the backing of the Community of Madrid, Madrid City Hall, ICEX Spain Export and Investments, and the sponsorship of Madrid FilmOffice and Film Madrid, among other collaborating entities.

The presentation in Málaga was led by Samuel Castro, co-director of Iberseries & Platino Industria, and Jesús Prieto, CFO, with Xiomara García, coordinador of Film Madrid, and Raúl Torquemada, director of Madrid Film Office. It was attended by numerous institutional representatives and professionals from the film and audiovisual industry.

The photographic and abstract elements aim to represent the diverse themes and the interplay between **film and series content**, reflecting the emblematic spirit of the new era.

The goal of these facilitated interactions is to create a dynamic space for collaboration and idea exchange. This, in turn, has the potential to unlock new audience segments and fuel global business growth.
