



Iberseries & Platino Industria and Berlinale Series Market to Connect Ten Production Companies from Germany and Ibero-America in Series Match

Companies from Brazil, Uruguay, Chile, Spain, and Germany will take part in this new initiative aimed at boosting the development and co-production of new international series projects.

Madrid, 26 January 2026. Ten German and Ibero-American production companies have been selected to participate in **Series Match: Germany & Ibero-America**, a new initiative promoted by **Iberseries & Platino Industria** and **Berlinale Series Market** with the goal of fostering international collaboration and the development of early-stage series projects.

The program will take place on **February 16** within the framework of the **Berlinale Series Market 2026** and will bring together five companies from each territory at the **Studio Babelsberg Lounge at CinemaxX**. Each company will present a series project in its initial development stage, supported by professional meetings designed to facilitate creative exchange and the formation of strategic partnerships.

The selected Ibero-American production companies are **Boutique Filmes** and **Movioca** (Brazil), **Alterna Media** (Uruguay), **Villano** (Chile), and **Funicular Films** (Spain). The German participants will be **Zeitsprung**, **UFA**, **SKP Entertainment**, **Studio Zentral**, and **Beta Film**.

The projects taking part in Series Match are: *Seven Women* (Boutique Filmes); *Abuse* (Federation, Ojo Films & Alterna Media); *Callback* (Funicular Films & Left Tackle Films); *Assassin in Paradise* (Movioca & Ginga Studios); *Scorched Earth* (Villano); *Driven Hunt – The Other Truth / The Runaway* (SKP Entertainment); *Wetlands* (UFA Fiction); and *Monika – Victory or Death* (Zeitsprung Pictures, Mariawood Producciones & Fine Time Filmproduktion).

With this newly curated format, **Series Match: Germany & Ibero-America** positions itself as a privileged space for the emergence of creative synergies, the promotion of innovative proposals, and the development of cross-border narratives with global reach. The initiative thus strengthens ties between the German and Ibero-American audiovisual markets and opens new opportunities for international co-production in the field of series.
